The European Summer Meeting LOGIC COLLOQUIUM 94 of the ASL has been held in Clermont-Ferrand (France) at the Université d'Auvergne, organized by the Laboratoire de Logique, Algorithmique et Informatique de Clermont (LLAIC) on 21–30 July 1994. The Meeting had 244 participants from 31 different nations.
